EYE MITRA ORGANIZED TRAINING FOR TRAINERS

To address the gaps and challenges experienced by the participants in training delivery, Eye Mitra team has scheduled a Training Program. The program was organized at Basix Guest House, New Delhi for its candidates.



The program was organized on June 23. The main aim of the training was to introduce newcomers to the field and enhance the skills of the experienced ones. Along with conversations various methods as interactive sessions, participatory sessions, audio –visual clips, storytelling, discussions and demos were used so as to simplify their understanding. Ms. Guneet Sethi & Ms. Chaarvi Mohan were the facilitators. Mr. Ved Prakash Sharma, Project Head EyeMitra and project co-ordinator Ms.Ashna Singh also witnessed the event.



NEW EYE MITRA CENTERS AT JAIPUR (RAJASTHAN) & BAHRAICH (UTTAR PRADESH)

B-ABLE has started two new Eye-Mitra centres in Jaipur and Bahraich (UP) in June 2016. Total 13 centres are now operational to impart training. The Eye-Mitra project is growing with a very fast pace. In this month 80 youths are promoted as Eye Mitra's entrepreneurs who have started their own business. Till June cumulative numbers of Eye-Mitras promoted by B-BALE is 1254 who are covering 49 districts over 12, 000 villages and serving approx. 2.4 crore people. These eye-mitras are now skilled who have done refraction of more than 11 lakh people. Including the enrollment in June 255 students are undergoing training to become full-fledged eye-mitras.



EYE-MITRA TEAM MEETS MSDE MINISTER

Project team with its 50 Eye Mitras approached and welcomed Shri. Rajiv Pratap Rudy, Honorable Minister of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship on 9th June during his Rampur visit .

FREELANCE TRAINERS' TRAINING

A 2.5 days training has been organized by industrial vertical in order to build a pool of freelance trainers. The focus of the training was to align the trainers with 'Life Skill Content' and simultaneously engage them with the methodology to be used to implement the same.



These trainers are being prepared for ongoing Shell Project. The event was organized and executed by Ms. Guneet Sethi and Ms. Chaarvi Mohan under the administration of Industrial Vertical Head Mr. Abhijit Mishra.

GOVERNMENT PROGRAMS

B-ABLE COVERED 626 SCHOOLS UNDER NSQF SCHEME TILL DATE

Impart Under Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India's initiative towards Revised Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Vocationalisation of Secondary Education in September 2011 B-ABLE has started imparting vocational education in government schools from class 9. It is operated within the National Skills of Qualifications Framework (NSQF). The program establishes a system of clear educational pathways from school to higher education which provides vocational education to the students of Government school. Till now B-ABLE has covered 626 schools under this program. Currently being offered from B-ABLE centres in Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Punjab, Chhattisgarh, West Bengal, Delhi and to be rolled out to other states.



SIKKIM SICB PROJECT RUNNING SUCCESSFULLY

B-ABLE has started working with State Institute of Capacity Building (SICB)-an autonomous department under HRD Dept Govt of Sikkim from August 2010. Firstly it has started with in sectors like Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry, Hotel, Hospitality, Tourism sectors, IT sectors, Beautician, SPA, Electrical, Home Appliances Repairing, Automobiles Repairing Services, Construction Trades etc. Initially B-ABLE started with 8 centers which gradually increased to 21 till 2015.

From 2010 to 2014 B-ABLE trained 2807. B-ABLE has pitched for new projects like DDGUKY, NULM, PMKVY and other state funded programs. The company is anticipating a good business in Sikkim in coming months. This year B-ABLE is executing PMKVY in Tripura in sectors like Agriculture and Rubber sector and till date the output is going good with enrolment of 300 and 1200 candidates respectively in both the sectors.

B-ABLE HAS STARTED A COMPUTER LITERACY PROGRAM WITH MITS

B-Able, in association with the Department of Tourism (DOT), Govt. of Meghalaya, initiated the “Placement Linked Capacity Building Course” in March 2013. These were 3 months non-residential programmes in Hospitality Assistant, Housekeeping Services and Entrepreneurship Development.

Since the inception, 388 candidates have been trained in Hospitality & housekeeping services. Out of them, 287 have been placed achieving a placement percentage of 73.96.

Moreover B-ABLE has started a computer literacy program with MITS from 27th June 16 (Meghalaya Information Tech Services) in collaboration with BSFL . It is mandate to train 800 candidates in the initial phase of the program which will be scaled up upon its completion. B-ABLE has roped in existing active CSC to execute the program across Meghalaya.
