Year 2016 was another successful year for the team Eye Mitra. In rural areas of IJP and Rajasthan the team promoted 1088 new micro entrepreneurs as Eve Mitra Opticians. Cumulative total Eye Mitras created in the program are 1966 in number.

Last year 15.70 lakh vision screening was done by these young entrepreneurs in rural

and facilitated areas 3.92 wearers. lakh Team of professionals including optometrist working for are development and sustainability of EMOs 50 districts. Eve Mitra team is organizing more than 1000 vision screening events in the villages every month. 2.5 NVG supporting the initiative to support 10000 rural youth in India.

Even the PMKVY application is in process, training in basic computer course was started and 36 girls are currently undergoing this training in two batches. The course is based on NIELIT/MES syllabus and the duration is 45 days with 2-3 hours of theory and practical classes each day.
